

Basically a 101-level mini review that essentially walks you through the outline of the exam. There are only a few real content takeaways, and nothing that you wouldn't know if you've already studied for the exam or have any substantial project management experience (which you should have for the exam anyway). I like the format of all of the speakers in a roundtable discussion, but there really isn't any content here to make it worth your time. I also don't appreciate that they constantly point out that some of the things they talk about don't work for audio and they just refer you to the book (which you may or may not have). All told, I wouldn't recommend this to someone...

This was the perfect addition based on my learning style. I didn't have a strong study plan due to my schedule, but I know the chart, remembered the formulas, understood the Code of Conduct, and listened intently to these CDs. I passed on the first try!

It really is "conversations" about the the exam, with 3 guys talking about it. I wish the goofy music between each session wasn't there. I wanted to play the CDs while I slept, hoping my subconscious would absorb the material, but that music just wakes me up!

While I used Rita's book primarily, I used these DVDs on the way to and from work for several weeks before passing the exam. If you want to pass the PMP and have a situation like I did, I highly recommend getting these DVDs to listen to. I listened to each one at least three times. By the week before the exam when I really started to study hard for the exam the terms from these DVDs were top of mind; this made it easier to study given this foundation. Just using these DVDs alone will not enable one to pass the PMP. I believe the prep. book that pairs with these DVDs would work will with them and provide the learning required to pass though.

For me, the CD was not a replacement for the book, rather it is a supplemental tool that helped reinforce my learning. There are some good tips and stronger emphasis on key points to remember for the exam, or ways that tricks are used to test your true understanding of the material. I used the PMBOK(of course), Andy's Book, the Flashcards as well as this CD to study for the exam, which I Passed on my First Try. Thanks Andy!!!Diclaimer/ Tip: You still must put in the reading time, work on the questions and exercises, and as many practice exams as possible. Make sure you are using newly aligned 5th edition materials. It would be a huge mistake to use 4th edition materials, as much of the content has changed.

Drive and learn all at the same time. If you are attentive, you will pick up tips along the way which help connect the dots between the processes. I'm happy I purchased this. The last CD explains certain exam tips which may be useful during the actual exam.

Lacks detailed content, but an OK value for the money. Better to spend a bit more money on Pritchard and Ward's cds than these. Good, however, if need a general introduction or a brief refresher. I did not feel these were much help for the PMP exam itself.

This was awesome! I listened to it in my car to and from work. You could also throw it on an mp3 player. It does NOT replace studying, however it is a really good overview and keeps your mind focused on passing PMP. I'd recommend it to a friend for sure.
