

I want to give it 5 stars, for me and my uses. I like to collect and display paper dolls. I want a second copy even, so I can cut out and arrange and display some, and have the others to frame as full pages. They are so cute, the dolls and the cut outs, but even how they look laid out on the page.Still, for people wanting to buy these for kids to play with? Well they are not perforated, but that is not a big deal. Dover paper dolls usually aren't. In fact, maybe they never are. An adult may need to help cut out. But the narrow necks with big heads, and the very thin arms, I can see as being problematic and easy to tear for kids. That made me consider giving only 4 stars.But no, 5 stars all the way. They are awesome.A suggestion, if buying for a kid - don't cut all the way to the neck. Leave a block of the white connecting the head and shoulders. You could also do the same between the insides of the arms, and the body. Then use an exacto knife to cut small slits wear the

tabs go in. My favorite paper dolls when I was young were the ones with hair hanging down and a little slit for the tabs in the hair, rather than an exposed neck. Kept the neck from getting bent, and also helped to keep the tabs in place, really. Another thing i did when I was young was to tape a toothpick or Popsicle stick along the back, to keep the neck straight and over all add some stability.

I don't think this paper dolls were meant to be played with. The heads are to big and the necks are to thin to support the big heads, the arms and legs are to thin. The heads, arms and legs would bend and tear if you cut them out to play with them. All the dresses are the same style just different colors. You only get one little dress in the middle of the page, some pages had two little dresses to a page and few pages so not that many outfits to play with. I think they are cute so I ordered them for my grand daughters to play with, but when I saw how unpractical they were to play with I decided to return them. This paper dolls are printed on good thick quality paper, they are very cute for those who like to collect paper dolls or like Mab Graves art. Each page has artwork of pictures of little bitty paint brushes, dog bones, the paper dolls pets, butterflies, bows, tiny little books and things like that along with only one or two dresses to a page. The artwork is to small to cut out and play with and if you cut out the dresses you would be throwing away all that nice artwork. This paper dolls are not for young children, too small and delicate to play with. I gave them 3 stars because I like the artwork but not as paper dolls.

I got two of these..one for me and one for my 5yr old granddaugther.we love them.they have cute outifts and assesseries.nice size and a modern look..I love all dolls big eyes....andI love there pets.you cant go wrong with these cuties.They must be cute out..they are not perferated get them and have some fun with yourself or a beloved youngster.

She doesn't want to mess up the paper dolls so she can keep them for ideas when she draws, so she copies them on our color copier & cuts those out to play with... (Clever girl.) These remind me of the Blythe dolls from the 70's... very retro!
