

For a while that meant Crystal Reports, but when SQL Server Reporting Services (SSRS) hit the scene, Crystal Reports began to fade on Microsoft projects. That was especially true if I had my way. I was the first person to champion SSRS in state projects in

Pennsylvania. That was quite a battle but well worth it!SSRS is one of the best solutions to come out of Microsoft. I don't say that lightly.
