The comprehensive version of this Microsoft Excel Book has easy to understand instructions for learning how to use Excel 2010. I have bought several other books by Gary B. Shelly and they have all been useful to me in the classes I have taken at college.

This book was a required book for a technical college program-based database program. The course curriculum followed along in the book for lessons and examples. It was good for learning all

the little things I never was aware of as a self taught excel user. Since the book was called comprehensive I would have liked to have seen more work on formulas, macros, and slicers as well as some visual basic beginning work. It did not address dashboards at all, which is a key aspect for today's advanced excel user. I did use the online resources that were available with the purchase of the book for studying for exams, etc. The size of the book was like a large textbook and laid flat on the table which was good for hands on work next to the keyboard. All in all a worthwhile purchase that I will definitely keep to use as a reference.

I have 2011 version for Mac this book is very close to that version. You will find that on a Mac some things are different however this book gives a detailed step by step instruction. I'm keeping after class for general knowledge.

It does provide step-by-step instructions, perhaps too much so at times since it tells you how to start Excel at the beginning of every single chapter, but better too much detail than not enough I suppose. I think I would have liked some exercises that challenge you to figure more out on your own, so that you're truly learning, and perhaps having an answer section at the back in case you do get stuck, but all in all an excellent instruction book.
