

It's tough to find a puppy book that covers everything, but this is as close as it gets. The instructions are clear and easy to follow, plus there are LOTS of photos that illustrate the various exercises. It includes not only those exercises that are considered "obedience" training, but exercises critical in the prevention of problem behaviors. As a professional trainer of 13+ years who has worked with 150 different breeds and over 4K dogs, I highly recommend this book for first time and experienced puppy owners.

This book is laid out nicely. First, read the PREFACE and Chapters 1-4 to get a great understanding of your dog before approaching training. The photos and key points in shaded boxes make it easy to absorb the information. The rest of the book identifies specific training and behavior how-to's, do's and don'ts. The book is very complete and all-encompassing, addressing practically everything that can be encountered while raising and caring for a dog with respect and kindness.

I am only more than half way through it but so far, it is amazing and I have recommended it to anyone who gets a puppy or even people who have grown dogs. It just has a plethora of information that no owner should be without! Best book I have bought.

First of all, the info in this book is spot on. Almost as important, it is easy to read, with clear images to support the text.
