

NOT everything you need to know. While I did pass the test for all three sections and core (i.e. Universal), I would say this book is really only 85% what you need. It is absolutely worth buying, but they need to focus more on the vacuum levels that need to be achieved. The actual dates were not tested such that you were quizzed what date any particular restriction went into effect. At least not on my test... Though the test did have some dates. I would have given this four (4) stars being it is worth 85%, but it claims to EVERYTHING (i.e. claims 100%) Hence, I reduced 1 star because this is incomplete, and the other star for misrepresentation.

This is the booklet that our instructor required us to have for our HVAC class at Ozarks Technical College, in Springfield, Mo. It is well written, has a lot of information to cover for taking your Core, Levels 1, 2 & 3 exams. We made 296 flashcards from the questions/answers, studied these for 2 months, then took our in class paper test. I passed with a 96 (missing one (1) out of each category. So, now I am a certified, universally licensed HVAC tech. This book helped me a lot, without a lot of extraneous fluff that fills out a lot of textbooks. I highly recommend this book. ENJOY!!!!!!

I ordered this despite the study guide our teacher gave us. Yes it is older but it less pages with majority of the same stuff as the new one and its less simple. My epa exam was 100 questions and i passed with 96 right and only got four wrong. Easy simple book

This seems to be everything you need to know to pass the certification. I took a sample test on ESCO's website and did alright with just a brief scan of the material. I cannot comment on the study guide's effectiveness for the an actual exam, for the job for which I applied turned out not requiring the certification. Therefore, I never took the actual test.

This is dense text. Best to study in chunks over a period of 20-30 days leading up to the test. If you invest the time the certification exam should be no problem. Unless you have prior HVAC regulatory training you should not expect to pick this manual up the night before the test and pass.

I had got my spa certification back in 2011.i don't know if I'll do anything with it or just go to college! This book is electronic and very helpful. It's about 500 plus pages and very ingormative. I would recommend it!

Informative without frills, BUT for a newbie who is not going to school for HVAC or refrigeration training there are several things missing. If you don't know what classifications the various refrigerants this book will not tell you. The description of the refrigerant cycle is accurate but not detailed enough to get a raw novice through the test without further study. If you are taking classes this book is what you want - if R22, HCFC or any of the other refrigerant names or classifications is new to you, look for something with a little fuller explanation.

Look NO further! Like others have said this works! I passed with about week and a half studying 1-2 hrs a day. Short and crammed FULL of the information you will need. Like the booklet says There are questions strait out of this booklet. If you read it and remember it you can pass. Like anything if you dont study it you will fail but, your cant blame the book cause everything you need to know for the test is in here.
